AMRITSAR – THE HOLY CITY

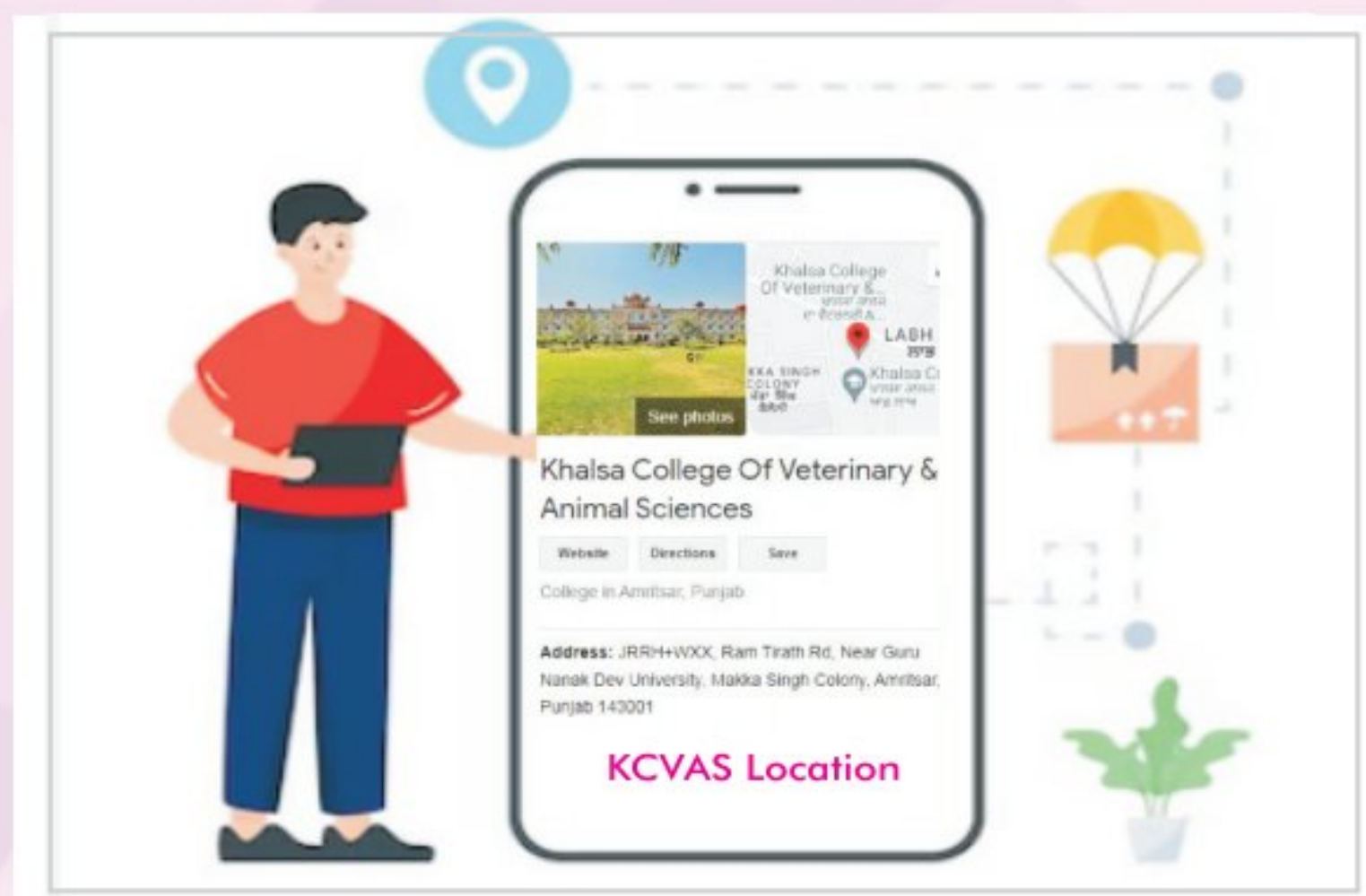

The diverse land of rich cultural heritage is famous for Sri Harmandir Sahib (Golden Temple), Jallianwala Bagh, Shri Durgiana Temple, Gobindgarh Fort and Attari - Wagah border.

VENUE

Call for Abstract/Papers

Lead papers and abstract with title author(s) name, e-mail address, name of institution, objectives, methods, results and conclusions (not exceeding 300 words) using MS word, Times New Roman (Font size 12 in double space) should be forwarded electronically to svae.amritsar2023@gmail.com before 30th September 2023. Abstract of paper should be based on the original works/concept of the author(s) and must not have been published anywhere. Name of the presenting author should be underlined. Only quality papers will be selected for presentation in the relevant technical sessions. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by a scientific committee and decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be communicated to the corresponding authors. Poster should be 150 cm in width and 90 cm in height.

Awards and Honors

The presentations/ posters will be evaluated by a jury of eminent scientists in each session. Best presentation/ poster will be awarded in the valedictory function of conference. Besides, the Society will honor few of the eminent scientists/ field functionaries for their contributions in the field of extension.

Note: Awards at Sr. No. 4 & 5 are open to all delegates and rests are for life members of SVAHE. Interested candidates are requested to submit their bio-data indicating salient achievements, NAAS rating papers, awards, etc. through e-mail & Hard Copy along with Demand Draft (DD) of processing fee of Rs. 2500/- favouring 5th National Conference SVAHE, Amritsar positively by 30th September, 2023. Applications will be screened by a committee on overall basis. Thesis awards (M.V.Sc./Ph.D) will be given one each for the thesis submitted in the calendar years 2022. Decision of the jury will be final and binding on applicants.
